

Instructions for Printing Watermarked Sheet

Paper as Bibliographical Evidence

Part 1: How Making Paper by Hand Impacts Its Characteristics

The preceding two pages (pp. 1–2 in the pdf) are the front and back of an imagined watermarked sheet of antique-laid paper. This can be folded into differing formats, such as folio, quarto, octavo, etc., as an aid for this online course.

Depending on your printer and the app you use to print, you may have to experiment to find the correct settings to print double-sided (duplex) so that the image on the back is reversed and positioned directly over the images on the front. Don't worry if your printer cannot place them exactly over one another; it will still be fine to use. If your printer gives you the option to "flip on short edge," try that option.
